Tripoli Central California

Mile High Challenge 2011 (fly your rocket to one mile high) 5,280 Ft. AGL

Here are the challenge rules & details:

- 1. All contestants must follow the Tripoli safety code
- 2. Fly your rocket to 5,280 above ground level (AGL), or as close as possible. The one closest to 5,280 feet above ground level (under or over 5,280 feet) is the declared the winner
- 3. Entry fee to make your attempt is \$3 per flight
- 4. Any qualified flyer may participate in the challenge
- 5. You may attempt as many times as you wish until end of the challenge
- 6. The challenge will run for 11 months January through November, 2011
- 7. Any rocket cleared by RSO just prior to flight may be entered
- 8. The motor must be certified, and CA OSFM-classified as a High Power Rocket motor.
- 9. The rocket must carry an unmodified commercially-available recording altimeter, which will be used after the flight to determine the peak apogee any altimeter which reports altitude is qualified, if you do not like that, don't take the challenge
- The rocket must make a safe, stable flight, and be recovered successfully (this will be determined by contest officials judgment)
- 11. Upon recovery, the rocket must be brought directly to a designated area to have the altimeter data read under supervision of one of the contest officials. Failure to do so may result in disqualification for that flight
- 12. Entry fees will be paid out to winner closest to 5280 feet AGL at conclusion of challenge
- 13. One time prize-First contestant to hit 5280 feet on the mark receives \$100 cash consideration for Whats Up Hobbies (This flight is archived and will not be included in the duration of the contest)
